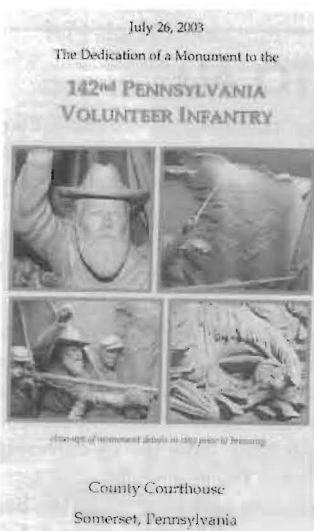

MOUNT HOR LODGE #736 ATTENDS PATRIOTIC EVENT

Let me begin with a little history on this event. On June 14th, 1885 a Fredonia, Wisconsin schoolteacher Bernard Cigrand, along with the children of his community, organized a celebration for the 108th birthday of our nation's flag. This original Flag Day soon was followed by the states of New York and Pennsylvania. In 1911 the Elks Grand Lodge took the lead by designating Flag Day as a required annual ceremonial day in all of its lodges nationwide.

Continual encouragement by the Elks resulted in an act of Congress proclaiming June 14th as National Flag Day. President Harry S. Truman signed this act into law on August 3, 1949.

So when the Huntingdon Elk's Lodge #976 invited Mount Hor Lodge #736 in 2002 to attend along with every civic and fraternity organization in Huntingdon County we were very proud to participate. For the second year, Odd Fellows were the most represented organization attending this Flag Day ceremony.

Brother Mowry, 87, was initiated into Old Monongahela Lodge #209 on October 30, 1952. He was a Past Grand of #209 and served as their Representative to the Grand Lodge for many years. He was also a Past Chief Patriarch of #109. He served many years on Home Boards and was Treasurer of the Board for the Odd Fellow and Rebekah Home of Western Pennsylvania until he retired from the Board.

He was born November 23, 1915 in Jefferson Township, a son of the late Charles Edward and Edith (Tompkins) Mowry. He was an insulator and retired after 27 years with Hercules, Inc., West Elizabeth. He was a member of the First Presbyterian Church of Elizabeth and a veteran of the U.S. Army, having served in World War II. He was also a life member and Past Noble Grand of Old Monongahela Lodge 209. He was also a member of Star of Glassport Rebekah Lodge 563, Monongahela Encampment 109 and a member of the Mon Valley Degree Lodge. Brother Mowry was the recipient of the Meritorious Service Award of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows. Brother Mowry was a member of the Board of Directors of the Medical Eye Bank Foundation of Western Pennsylvania, the Western Pennsylvania Historical Society, and a former member and investment officer of the Odd Fellows and Rebekah Home of Western Pennsylvania. Bill served as a representative to the Grand Lodge of Pennsylvania and served on many committees during his tenure as a representative. Mowry was proficient in the degree work of the order.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife Rozella, who died on July 9, 2003. He is survived by his daughter Linda; a foster son Terry Troxell; his brother Gale; one grandchildren; and nieces and nephews.

He was interned in Round Hill Cemetery, Elizabeth Township.
