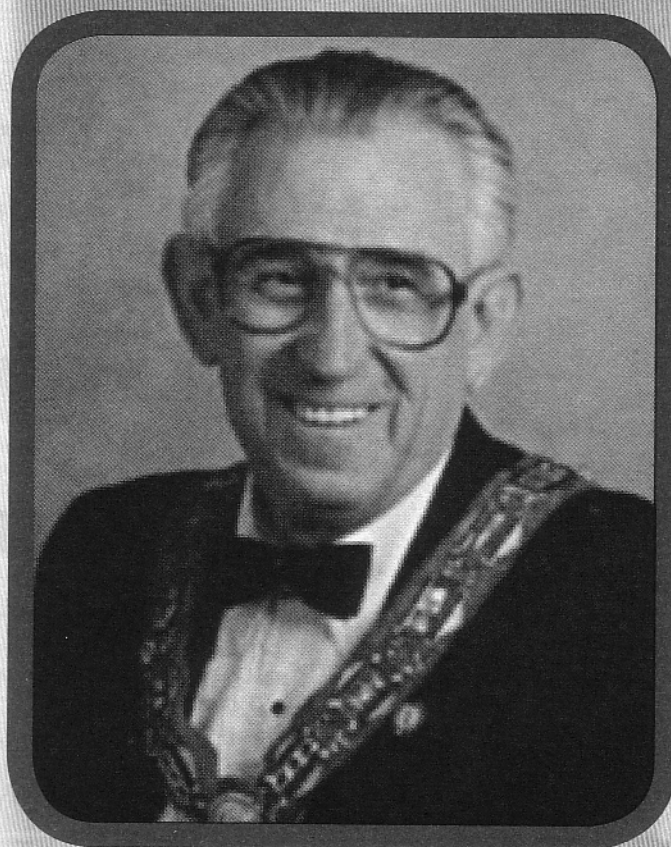

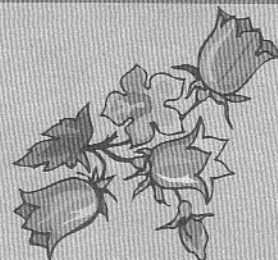
Brother William Lincoln Locke, 86, of Hermitage and Middletown, PA was initiated an Odd Fellow in Adoniram Lodge Number 739, Sharpsville, on the 15th day of November, 1948. He became a Past Grand on October 3rd, 1952 and received his Grand Lodge Degree on April 24, 1953. He held several positions after this and was Treasurer and Representative to Grand Lodge for several years. He held the office of District Deputy Grand Master from 1981-1983. In 1985, he was elected to Grand Warden and in 1987 he was installed in Harrisburg as our Grand Master. He later became a member of Sandy Lake Lodge #573 through consolidation on June 16, 2008. He held associate memberships currently with Walker Lodge #306, Philadelphia and Triune Lodge #307, Middletown. As well as serving currently as our Grand Secretary since 2002, he was also our Alternate Sovereign Grand Lodge Representative. One of his biggest achievements was being the head editor of the Pennsylvania Odd Fellow and Rebekah Magazine.

In 1979, he became a Patriarch of Shenango Encampment #186, serving as Chief Patriarch and served over 10 years as District Deputy Grand Patriarch. He served as Grand Outside Sentinel for Past Grand Patriarch Howard Chew from 1993-1994 and then went on to serve as Grand Patriarch of the Grand Encampment of Pennsylvania from 1997-1998. He then became a Patriarch of Kossuth Encampment #98, of Warren in 2006. He held higher membership in the Patriarchs Militant, having joined Meadville Canton #47 in 1979 and later becoming a member of Canton York #14. He is a Past Commandant, last rank being a Major and served as Department Council Chaplain under Past Department Commander Herman Schlott.

He joined Sharpville Rebekah Lodge #110 on February 23, 1978 and then Endeavor Rebekah Lodge #367 by card in 1995. Currently, he was the Treasurer of Red Rose Rebekah Lodge #586 of Middletown. He was representative for numerous years for the different branches, having been at every Session since 1978 and risen to the rank of Sovereign Grand Lodge Representative from 2007-2011. He was active on several committees, having served as chairman of the By-Law committee for 11 years. He conducted instruction seminars, served as Pop on the United Nations Pilgrimage for youth and was a Past President of the Sovereign Grand Lodge Region 3 Home Association. He served on the Meadville Home Board, 8 years as President and currently was serving on the Odd Fellows and Rebekah Association of Western PA since 1990 and Fellowship Manor since 2000 as well as Treasurer of the PM & LAPM Rally Committee.

He was a WWII U.S. Army Veteran, Purple Heart recipient and a member of the Clark Trinity United Methodist Church.

Surviving is his sweetheart and wife, the former Laura J. Ellis, Past RA Secretary, two daughters, two sons, five grandsons, four daughters, six great-grandchildren and a great-great-grandson. He was the second living sibling of eight with one brother surviving.

Grand Lodge services were conducted and burial with Military Honors was held in Glenwood Cemetery, Clark, PA.

As many hats as this Brother wore, in his acceptance speech as Grand Master, he stressed how much easier life in Odd Fellowship would be if everyone worked together and supported each other. "One thing that would be helpful in promoting Odd Fellowship is to live it. If you are having a problem with a Brother or Sister, solve it in friendship. Show people outside the Order we really believe and practice Friendship, Love and Truth. If you show people how good it is, they will want to join." Several times in the magazine, we were asked by him to rededicate ourselves to Odd Fellowship and look back at the obligation we took when we bonded with each other in Fraternity. During this tumultuous time in Odd Fellowship, we really should follow his words.

* In closing, I want to say how hard it was to write this obituary as he not only was my boss, he was my friend, my mentor, and my Brother. He was such a proud Odd Fellow; he loved this Order greatly and always spoke to people about it. I do not see that much pride from most members in my travels. It was an honor working for

him and listening to his stories and counsel. He had a lot of knowledge in this order and it always fell back to friendship, love and truth. He wouldn't think twice when it came to traveling across the state for an Odd Fellow function. Too often we hear "I just don't have time for Lodge." This Brother showed it can be done and his time away from us until we will meet him again will leave a long time void in our Jurisdiction.

Second oldest tenured member in Pennsylvania
Montgomery-Curtis-Norris Lodge No. 57
Norristown Encampment No. 37
February 23, 2012



Brother George C. Quier, 102, of Norristown, PA, was initiated into Montgomery Lodge #57, Norristown, on June 10, 1929. He was raised in the Philadelphia Orphanage at 8 years old, with his two brothers, Curtis, who passed away at the age of 95 and his oldest brother, Calvin, who is 106 and the oldest Odd Fellow tenured in Pennsylvania, having joined in 1925. He and his brothers marched in the 1919 100th

anniversary of Odd Fellowship in America in Baltimore, MD. He became a Patriarch of Norristown Encampment #37, joining January 13, 1939 and receiving his Golden Rule and Royal Purple Degrees on July 11, 1939. He was a Past Chief Patriarch and Past Grand, having received his Grand Lodge Degree on November 16, 1954. He became a member of Montgomery-Curtis-Norris Lodge #57, when the three Lodges consolidated into one of September 27, 1954. He held the position of Scribe of the Encampment for many years, up until this past term.

He was a WWII and Korean Conflict U.S. Army Veteran and a member of the Trinity Lutheran Church of Fairview Village. He continued working well into last year at the Mercy Suburban Hospital, 7 hours a day, 5 days a week.

He was preceded in death by his wife, the former Ada Mary Carter. Surviving in addition to his brother are nieces and nephews.

Burial was held in Whitemarsh Memorial Park.

A main highlight of his time with the Lodge was February 18th, 2010, when he was presented with an 80 year pin at a dinner with PGM Harvey for his 100th birthday. He was presented with proclamations by local and national dignitaries such as the Supervisors of East Norriton Township, The Montgomery County Commissioners, State Representative of the 70th District Matthew Bradford, State Senator of the 17th District David Leach, 6th District Congressman Jim Gerlach, Governor Ed G. Rendell and Senators Arlen Specter and Robert Casey. Attached below is an excerpt from the House of Representatives:

His roots in the Odd Fellows organization run deep, as George, and his 103-year-old brother, Calvin, were raised in the Odd Fellows Philadelphia orphanage. And George, who bravely served our country in the Army for 22 years, has been a member of the Odd Fellows for more than 80 years. To this day, he faithfully fulfills the Odd Fellows pledge to visit the sick and relieve the distressed by volunteering seven hours per day, five days per week at Mercy Suburban Hospital.
