DGM BAILEY PLACES WREATH IN MEMORY OF THOMAS WILDEY

Thomas Wildey was coined as the Founder of North American Odd Fellowship. Raised as an orphan in England and immigrated to America in 1817. Roughly 2 years, later, an ad carefully placed in Baltimore's Newspaper sparked interest in four other men to meet in the Seven Stars Tavern and the rest became history. Thomas Wildey died in 1861, 42 years after Odd Fellowship was founded. During that year, there were more than 200,000 members of the Odd Fellows across the United States of America, growing to be the worlds largest organization.

Each year, around the date of his death, October 19th, the Grand Lodge of Maryland hosts a memorial service in his memory. Eleven wreaths from various jurisdictions, including SGL and Lodges in Hawaii, Denmark and Sweden were placed at the Grand Lodge of Maryland's new

Headquarters in Dundalk, Maryland. DGM Bailey had the honor of placing a wreath Representing the Jurisdiction of Pennsylvania in the 151st year of Brother Wildey's death. After the wreath placings, Walter Hoenes, Grand Marshal of the SGL gave a Eulogy for Brother Wildey.

Comments were then made by visiting dignitaries and tours of their new beautiful office building, Lodge Hall and Museum were then given. Also in attendance from Pennsylvania was Kate L. Bailey, NG Lady Harmony Rebekah Lodge #86 and Linda Dickson and Kimberly Fairchild of Lady Worth Rebekah Lodge #328. Special thanks to PGM Shirley Sell of MD and the Thomas Wildey Committee for this fantastic event. This is definitely an event to look into going to in the future.




