

P.O.F. DAYS GONE BY

75 YEARS AGO (July 1937)

GRAND LODGE SESSION – "In order that Grand Lodge might liquidate its indebtedness, the Body imposed a .05 per term (two terms) be levied per member. This meant the price of two cigars or one soda to the member but it also meant \$10,000.00 to Grand Lodge" There were 584 Representatives present out of 963. (Last year we had 33 out of 86).

SHENANDOAH #591 – entertained Grand Lodge and Lodges from the four corners of Schuylkill Cty. Discussion were held on the upcoming annual IOOF auto run. 7/11 at Sunbury Orphanage, 8/22 at Middletown Home.

LETTER FROM ENGLAND - A letter from Sons of Liberty Lodge regarding an active member whom moved back to his native England in 1930. He wanted to transfer and at that time there were no provisions for transfers out of state. Therefore he left \$10.00 toward future dues and kept in contact with the Lodge. In 1937 the Lodge received notice that this man's wife and newborn child died along with death certificates. They upon receiving this sent him a \$100.00 death benefit. They received a letter back thanking for the 20 pounds, 5 shillings he received with a letter stating he didn't think he qualified for this since he left the country, his purpose was to just notify his friends he left behind of her death. His expressed the importance of younger men joining the Odd Fellows, never realizing the help that could be given in a time of need.

50 YEARS AGO (July 1962)

FRATERNITY IN CRISIS

Our fraternity and all others constituted the same as ours are in crisis. We have been robbed of our primary function of direct aid to those who were injured and killed while working in the mills. At one time, where ever there was a factory, there was an Odd Fellow Lodge close by. In industrial areas, there could be two or three lodges in that town or city.

In 1942, when we found that we were involved in a global war, things began to change. Factories needed more workers in order to keep up with the productions needed for the war effort. However, Industry was not allowed to compete for the limited amount of workers available by offering increased wages. That would have resulted in hyper-inflation. Factories began to offer health and life insurance to entice workers to go to work for them. It wasn't long after that individual states required industry to buy disability insurance. What is there left for us to do?


We still have to "Visit the sick" "bury the dead" "Educate the orphan", but that has its own set of problems. There are federal and state programs to help those people without funds to feed and cloth themselves, There are no more orphanages! We have foster care! I'm not really sure how those without resources or family who die are buried. I assume they get buried, but who takes care of that is a mystery to me.

I have been a member of Odd Fellows for over twenty years, and the mantra of "Get New Members" is and was chanted by every Grand Master across the wide world. But without a clear mission, new members leave because there is no clear mission, and really nothing to do. This generation of people demand immediate gratification. If they do something, they want to see the immediate results. Academic scholarships do not provide immediate results. The problem remains. We need a 'Cause' that will bring people to us willing to help meet the needs of that cause; I for one am still looking, with hope in my heart, for that new cause.
