

Brother Ellwood L. 
MIDDLETOWN HOME RESIDENT OF THE MONTH




LOST TREASURE FOUND IN GRAND LODGE VAULT

Now that I have everyone's attention, I am happy to report while cleaning the back shelves of the Grand Lodge vault, a forgotten treasure was found and will make it's final appearance in PA at the annual communication in June. In 1929, Vancouver – Hastings Lodge #8, British Columbia started circulating throughout British Columbia a heavy and very beautiful Traveling Gavel, along with a registry book and letter until 1974. These items were presented, July 10, 1974 to Sovereign Grand Master Shelby McCauley at Session in Arizona to "convey to his home Lodge as the first long step on its journey. As this gavel starts its journey from our fair city of the Pacific, it is our hope that it will travel eastbound to the Atlantic shores before it once again returns to its home Lodge." My brothers and sisters from 1974 to 1992, according to the register has traveled through

Arizona, Oregon, Nevada, Utah, New Mexico, Colorado, N. Dakota, Minnesota to W. Virginia, then Delaware where in 1992 they presented this to Walker Lodge #306. It traveled through Pennsylvania arriving at Grand Lodge Session in June 1996 and was used by the heads of our order to preside a day at Session. It continued to travel until July 1999 when it went to Mahanoy #551 and was returned to Grand Lodge, stored in our safe for future travel. It is time, 83 years later to start its journey home. I presented it to the two newest Lodges in PA, Harmony #86 & Lady Harmony Rebekah #86 to use at their meetings. It will be at Session this month for our Grand Master and President to use, after which will be presented to DSGM Charles Renninger to go to his home Jurisdiction of Washington DC and begin its travel back to the "Pacific Shore"
