Brother Roy E. Barron, Jr. answered the final roll call on December 3, 2011, after suffering a long and often painful illness. He was 75 years old.

Roy was a long-standing trustee of Alma Lodge #523 and instrumental in maintaining and assuring the physical and fiscal stability of his Lodge. No one worked longer or harder to insure all was well than Roy. This was his mission and he accomplished it in an outstanding manner.

Being a trustee meant more to Roy than just having his name listed beside a title. Many days Roy was at Alma Hall, often with one or both of the other Trustees, to see that a project was being completed properly, to respond to a maintenance problem or a call from one of the tenants, or to inspect the building after a serious rain or snow storm. Roy gave of his time generously and the current condition of our physical property is the result.

Roy probably understood securities and investments better than most people and displayed his leadership in guiding the Lodge along a conservative and responsible financial path for many years. We were not going to do anything foolish or irresponsible during Roy's watch. He knew that we had to adopt a strategy of long-term, conservative growth to keep up with inflation, yet not expose ourselves to unnecessary risk in the hopes of making a huge, short-term profit, and he never panicked when investments fell in value during perfectly normal market cycles. I can tell you from personal experience, as a retired securities broker who had Alma Lodge as a client, that those in my business wished all our clients took the Roy Barron approach to investing.

Every organization needs a Roy Barron. A dedicated, totally honest, loyal and wise leader who will guide the organization on the proper course, work tirelessly to see that things get done properly, and not require any special attention for his services. Doing most of his work behind the scenes, in conjunction with the other two Trustees, Roy was truly a god-send to Alma Lodge.

On a personal note, Roy loved cars and trucks, especially older ones and Fords. He was a wealth of knowledge about things automotive and I picked his brain many times when I was needing some advice on one of my projects. It was amazing what he had in his head about older automobiles. I will miss those conversations, Brother.

Roy is survived by his loving wife, Margaret, to whom he was married 50 years, his 3 children, 4 grandchildren, and several nieces and nephews.

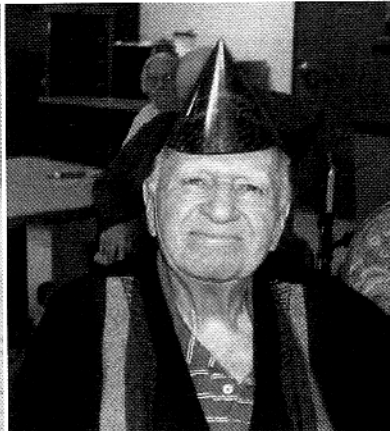

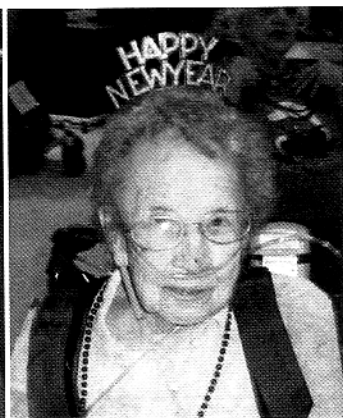

This fitness program includes music with fast and slow rhythms. The music comes from dance styles such as the salsa, mambo, and tango, just to name a few.

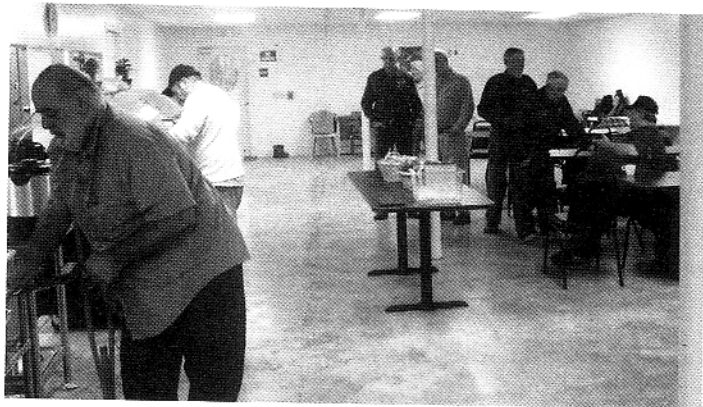

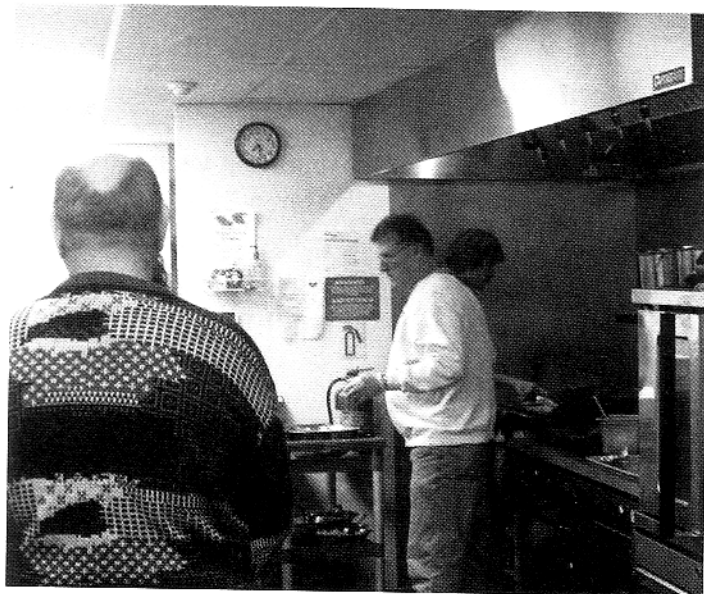

COST: of the bus will be \$45.00 per person over 10 yrs. The breakfast and supper will be at your cost.

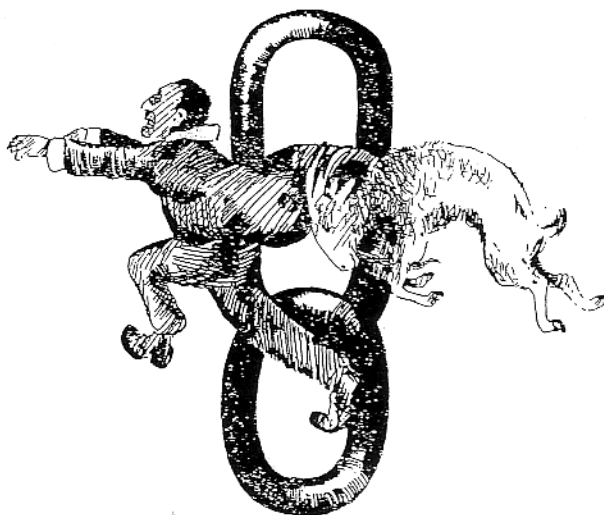
