ALMOST AN ODD FELLOW

Dino Campanis died Friday March 16, 2012. I don't expect anyone outside the State College area to recognize the name or even care. But a few years ago I gave Dino an application for membership and he filled it out and even paid the initiation fee. On the evening that Dino was to be initiated he fell sick and was not brought into the order.

Before then, Dino had developed his own project of sending shoe box size packages over seas to our people in uniform in Iraq and Afghanistan. The packages contained toiletries, candy and whatever would fit in the box. I visited Dino one November day and he told me he was getting some boxes ready to send. I saw several empty medicine bottles on his work bench and I asked him about them. "I'm preparing some cough medicine to send out," he replied. I questioned the cough medicine. "Well," he said, "It will taste a lot like Jack Daniels."

Dino's heart was as big as all out doors, but not very strong. He worked hard to keep his shop open at least three days a week. Even though his work week was diminished, his 'Shoe Box' project was not. The walls of his store are filled with letters of 'Thank You and Commendation' from soldiers and units that received packages from Dino. I have contacted everyone who I knew was connected to Dino, in order to find out where the 'shoe box project' was now that Dino had died. Was Dino the sole perpetrator of the program or were there other people involved. So far I cannot find anyone else who had been helping. I think that the 'Shoe Box' project is a perfect fit as an Odd Fellow activity. I am sorry that Dino never became an Odd Fellow and even sorrier that this Odd Fellow type project seems to have died with him.
