
PLAN NOW TO ATTEND THE PILGRIMAGE TO THE TOMB

His hobby is visiting his daughter whom lives in another state. Brother Ray works as a shift manager at Taco Bell in Grove City.



Greetings! This article was found in the Oregon Pacific Odd Fellow, December 2012. We feel this is something as not all laws, procedures, or charge books will hold, however very important. This is something that has torn down Lodges in the past and it still is seen in other Lodges. As we have entered 2013, let's renew our Lodges and work with these situations in securing a future:

Dealing with conflict

There is one topic that always seems to arise whenever I present a seminar on Membership. That is: "How do we deal with conflict in the Lodge"? Each situation must be dealt with on an individual basis, but I hope to address a few instances and solutions in this article.

The first situation is the "one member that is always negative with all suggestions for action. I hear people say, "We have one member that stops everything we try to do". Well, first of all it takes 5 members for a quorum. If one person is against something there are still at least 4 others to vote in favor of the project. If a lodge allows one person to stop all the activity, then I say shame on the rest of the members of the lodge. It is always difficult to stand up to a strong personality, but my Brothers and Sisters, we need activity in our Lodges to keep our members interested and we need activity in our communities to let our communities know we are alive and well. We have been asked to make a difference in our communities, we cannot do that if we allow that "one" person to influence our lodge in a negative way. The hardest thing is to be the one to stand up in lodge and give the explanation of the benefit of the project without attacking the person who is negative. Remember it should never be a personal attack when discussing projects. A difference of opinion should be able to be voiced without creating arguments. The first time is the hardest. Each time a member brings up the positive side of the situation it will get easier, until there is good discussion and a more informed decision will be made.

Another difficulty is the member who tries to be helpful, and gets the lodge involved in activities without action of the lodge. It is hard to put a damper on that gung-ho member, but sometimes an activity may not be the best fit for the lodge. We all think our ideas are best. We all have different interests so what interests us has got to be better, right? We as members should bring up ideas for activity at a regular meeting of the lodge. Technically it should then go to a committee to check out and investigate the pros and cons of the activity to be presented at the next meeting. Many

times we think a project sounds good only to find out there may need to be more involvement than originally thought, or the cost or time commitment on our part may be more than the lodge can keep up with. Anytime we take on a project it is important to be able to fulfill the obligation to the project in a credible manner. In order to represent the best image of the lodge, the members who represent the lodge in the public eye should be the best examples of the lodge. The best way to make sure the people who represent the lodge are the best examples is to do continuing education with members. Knowing the product makes it easier to sell. Studying the ritual and understanding the degrees and their meanings, knowing the projects of the Order, and what we are involved in and stand for, make it easier to talk to the public and set a good example. Working together on education and choice of activities will solve many of the gung-ho member conflicts.

The last conflict that I am going to address is the conflict of personalities that appear occasionally in a lodge. For every project or idea that is presented there will very probably be opposing ideas on how to do whatever it is or even whether to participate in it at all. The problem tends to arise when someone who opposes the idea and speaks against it, it comes out as appearing to attack the person instead of the idea. This can immediately create a division in the lodge and ill feelings between members. The best solution to this problem is to think before we speak out against something and be sure it is not against the person presenting it.

We are now in the middle of the Holiday Season. With all the extra activities, sometimes we need to remember that everyone is busier at this time of the year so we need to be more tolerant of others. By doing this we can avoid some of the conflict and keep Happy into our Holidays.


