# GRAND LODGE TRAVELS BACK IN TIME TO HELP SAVE A DYNASTY

Known as the original "Gateway to the West," Carlisle became a strong center for the southern part of Pennsylvania and for the Odd Fellows in general. Several years back, Unified Sessions were held at the Embers in Carlisle, but slowly and quietly, Carlisle Lodge #91 slipped out of existence, consolidating in 1991 with Bowmansdale Lodge #1179. Carlisle

was also home to 2 Encampments and one Rebekah Lodge.

Over the course of time the hall was sold once or twice and landed in the hands of the Cumberland County Historical Society. Realizing they had a gem of a building, they decided to contact Grand Lodge. The building was rebuilt in the 1920's in a gothic manor of one which many of our

members have never seen. It sits quietly on North Pitt Street, with hints of glamour showing in its stained glass windows, old brass lanterns, along with the Old English IOOF standing out in the middle.

To walk into the main double doors of the third floor hall, however, almost takes your breath away. Huge painted murals adorn the walls and cathedral style ceiling, showing depictions of the degree work of the Odd Fellow, Rebekah and Encampment Lodges. However, from years of damage to the roof, they have fallen badly into disrepair. Over the past 10 years, the Historical Society has funneled over \$900,000 into maintaining the property. After talking with them though, it is surprising to see how proud they are to understand and learn what treasures and mysteries lay within the murals. They are going full force to restore this temple and want the Odd Fellows right at their side helping to preserve something as rare as this.

As you have seen in the board minutes of the Grand Lodge, steps are being taken to work with them in restoring this building, and reinstituting a Lodge back in Carlisle. They are willing to work with us in a meeting hall and we are willing to work with them. This can be used as not only a hall, but a museum as we all know the saying "a picture is worth a thousand words." Unfortunately, the pictures you see in the magazine here do no justice to the breathtaking marvels that adorn the walls. Showing right on the main street are the stained glass windows, with emblems from the Order. The first floor is divided into two – a historical society gift shop, and the other half to be set up for a discovery center for people to come in and learn about Cumberland County. One of their stations will go into the service/ fraternal organizations that built up Cumberland County.

At one time, Cumberland County had 12 Lodges, 5 Rebekah Lodges and 6 Encampments. Today, two Lodges and one Encampment survive, but are both growing. We are at a crossroads in the future of Odd Fellowship where we can help rebuild something worth saving and honoring the name that adorns this building, or we can do what we have done years past and sit back and watch it fall through our fingers. The wonderful part is not only do we see this buildings potential, but the Historical Society does also, and is willing to help preserve history. Hopefully, more is in the future for this building, and we can start rebuilding Odd Fellowship, starting with the former Carlisle Lodge No. 91, I.O.O.F.

# THE TREASURER'S TALES - APRIL 2015

Winter was over and time had come for spring and those things that remind us of spring. The lodge usually held an Easter Egg hunt the Saturday before Easter. In April 1920, the trend would continue.

Easter was April 4, 1920, and the day that daylight savings time started. The day for the Easter Egg hunt was Saturday, April 3, 1920. Winter was over and the temperature hung around the low 40's. Spring was reflected in the plants and animals.

The lodge was accustomed to using homemade Easter Eggs. There were no inexpensive food colors and the coloration was achieved by boiling the eggs with different vegetable matter to produce the desired result. Onion skins produced a light brown egg, Oak bark or Black Walnut shells produced black eggs, young apple tree bark produced a golden color, violet coloration came from the petals of the mallow flower, young rye shoots produced green and beet juice produced pink. The Rebekahs brought their coloring materials and Barney supplied the eggs. They colored fifty dozen eggs. Enough for all the children to get a half dozen each (imagine getting 100 children at an Odd Fellows event today). The members of the lodge decided to hide them at 8:00 a.m. on Saturday and invite the children at 11:00 a.m. This would give them time to do a good job.

At 11:00 a.m. the children came to the lodge hall, each was given an area to search and left go. It became apparent that someone had been taking the eggs. One of the children brought back a handful of broken shells. Barney and his helpers, Vic and Clancey, were out looking at the mess when they noticed a "bump" in high grass toward the edge of the woods. Inspection of the bump revealed it was a raccoon with protruding belly and the appearance of suffering from a tummy ache. The culprit had been caught. One of the parents was about to retrieve a .22 rifle and dispatch the thief, but all the children protested. They wanted to keep the raccoon. Barney found a wooden crate and coaxed the raccoon into it with another egg.

The children were brought back in the lodge hall to share the eggs that were gathered and get hot cocoa. Barney had a few dozen eggs left in the ice box and was able to make sure each child got at least two eggs. The Rebekahs had made peanut butter eggs coated in chocolate to pass out.

For those who follow Barney's exploits, the January 2010 story was about a raccoon as well. This time the children of the Noble Grand of the Rebekahs took the raccoon home. A little investigation proved that the raccoon was a pregnant female. She became the toast of the Rebekahs. They named her Rebekah. They kept her and her litter in a cage in the lot behind the lodge hall. When the Memorial Day parade took place, she was on the float. Her name and the names of her three offspring, who were small, were placed on cards on the float. The small raccoons were David, Jonathan and Melchizedek, all boys.

She lived in captivity for fourteen years but her young were released into the wild when they reached six months. She made many parades and always looked forward to Easter and the left overs from the lodge meetings. She got replaced by Fido in January 1942, but that is another story.

The moral of the story is to be careful when you hide things, you never know who might find them.


# CENTRE LODGE NO. 153 MUSIC JAM, HELD MARCH 8, 2015
